

REPORT OF THE SENATE SUBCOMMITTEE
ON RETENTION AND TRANSFER

I. NEW BUSINESS

The following items were submitted to the Subcommittee on Retention and Transfer for consideration:

#RT-37 - Major in Elementary and Kindergarten Education (entrance requirement)

Admission to the major requires a 2.50 GPA and will be contingent upon successful completion of EDPSY 014 and EDTHP 115.

#RT-38 - Major in Secondary Education (entrance requirement)

Admission to the major requires a 2.50 GPA and will be contingent upon successful completion of C I 295, EDPSY 014, and EDTHP 115.

#RT-39 - Major in Health Education (entrance requirement)

Change the existing "Natural Sciences and Social and Behavioral Sciences" statement on page 161 of the 1985-86 Bulletin. Section 1 would then read:

1. Completion, with a 2.00 grade-point average, of applicable courses within the Baccalaureate Degree Requirements including:

Communications--6 credits (ENGL 015 and SPCOM 100A)

Quantification--3 credits (MATH, except 004, 035, and 036)

Natural Sciences and Social and Behavioral Sciences--6 credits selected from University list in social and behavioral sciences; BI SC 003 or 004 or BIOL 041.
