

REPORT OF THE SENATE SUBCOMMITTEE ON
RETENTION AND TRANSFER

I. NEW BUSINESS

The following changes in entrance and retention requirements were submitted to the Subcommittee on Retention and Transfer for consideration. Action taken by the subcommittee will be reported on a subsequent Blue Sheet.

#RT-42 - Major in Computer Science (entrance requirement)

To enter the baccalaureate Computer Science major, a student ^{shall} must have achieved a minimum cumulative grade-point average of 2.50 or greater in Penn State course work at the time of seeking entrance to the major. Additionally, the student must have completed CMPSC 120, MATH 140, and MATH 141 and obtained a passing grade in each course with a grade-point average of at least 2.50 in these courses.

#RT-43 - Major in Computer Science (retention requirement)

To be retained as a Computer Science major beyond the fifth semester, a student must have completed CMPSC 101 or 103, CMPSC 120, 211, and MATH 311, and obtained a passing grade in each course and a grade-point average of at least 2.50 in these courses. A student also must have completed MATH 140, 141, 220, 230, and STAT 318, and obtained a passing grade in each course and a grade-point average of at least 2.00 in these courses.
